If you wish to receive a copy of the documents you are dropping off, or are giving us the originals and want them back, please note that on the form.

If you are making a payment, please put your payment in a sealed envelope. DO NOT put loose checks/money orders through the drop slot.

All HOSWWA staff have a voicemail extension. Please call our office to request voicemail extensions or email addresses.

Annual inspections will be postponed. By regulation we must perform HQS inspections. Once the peak contagious period is over, HQS inspections will be rescheduled and resume in a normal manner. Unit inspections for families new to the program will still take place.
